**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY ON THE RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION  
FROM SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a study to provide
- 2 data, via contact tracing, on the number of students who claim a
- 3 religious exemption from school immunization requirements who were
- 4 the source of transmission of a vaccine-preventable disease to an
- 5 immunocompromised student or any unvaccinated person in a day
- 6 care, school or camp in the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require a study to provide data, via contact tracing, on the number of students who claim a religious exemption from school immunization requirements who were the source of transmission of a vaccine-preventable disease to an immunocompromised student or any unvaccinated person in a day care, school or camp in the state.
