AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE BEFORE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY EXECUTIVE ORDER OR DECLARATION AFFECTING BUSINESSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that the Governor
- 2 provide ten days' notice to the public before the effective date of any
- 3 executive order, declaration or modification of an executive order or
- 4 declaration that restricts a business' ability to operate or capacity to do
- 5 business, in whole or in part.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide businesses with ten days' notice before the effective date of any executive order or declaration that restricts a business' ability to operate or capacity to do business.
