**AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE AND USE OF CONSUMER GRADE FIREWORKS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) expand the type of
- 2 fireworks that may be legally sold and used in this state by allowing the
- 3 sale and use of all consumer fireworks permitted by federal law; (2)
- 4 require sellers of fireworks to obtain a federal, state and local license to
- 5 sell fireworks; (3) set the state licensing fee at two thousand five
- 6 hundred dollars; and (4) allow licensees to sell consumer fireworks only
- 7 from a permanent structure constructed in compliance with the State
- 8 Building Code and the State Fire Prevention Code.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit the sale and use of consumer grade fireworks.
