**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGIONALIZATION OF CERTAIN
PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATIONS CENTERS
AND A STUDY OF CONSOLIDATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection,
- 2 in consultation with municipal chief elected officials and municipal
- 3 public safety leaders, shall develop and report to the General Assembly
- 4 by July 1, 2022, a public safety answering points consolidation plan,
- 5 specifying that on or after July 1, 2028, public safety answering points
- 6 must serve populations of at least forty thousand persons in order to be
- 7 eligible for enhanced 9-1-1 funding, provided resources from the
- 8 Enhanced 9-1-1 Telecommunications Fund may be used to develop such
- 9 plan.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection, in consultation with municipal chief elected officials and municipal public safety leaders, to develop a public safety answering points consolidation plan.
