**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP TO
DELIVER COST-EFFECTIVE HUMAN SERVICES AND DETER FRAUD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a partnership
- 2 between state human service agencies and private providers to (1)
- 3 improve delivery of human services to low-income persons, elderly
- 4 persons and persons with disabilities, (2) reduce the cost of such
- 5 services, and (3) foster fraud investigations to uncover ineligible persons
- 6 wrongfully receiving public assistance.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve the cost-effective delivery of human services and make sure
such services are given only to those in need.
