***RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT TO ALLOW SIXTEEN-YEAR-OLDS TO PREREGISTER
TO VOTE, REGIONAL VOTING CENTERS AND EARLY VOTING.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to allow (1) individuals
- 2 who have attained the age of sixteen years to apply for admission as an
- 3 elector such that they will be admitted as electors upon attaining the age
- 4 of eighteen years, (2) the establishment of regional voting centers at
- 5 which multiple municipalities may receive the votes of the electors
- 6 within such municipalities, and (3) electors to cast ballots at an election
- 7 prior to the day of such election.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the Constitution of the state to allow sixteen-year-olds to preregister to vote, regional voting centers and early voting.
