"AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC HEALTH AND CIVIL PREPAREDNESS EMERGENCIES DECLARED AND RENEWED BY THE GOVERNOR."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the
4 provisions of sections 19a-131a and 28-9 of the general statutes, any
5 declaration of a public health emergency or civil preparedness
6 emergency issued by the Governor on or after the effective date of this
7 act that extends beyond seven days shall be ratified or rejected by a
8 majority vote of the Senate and House of Representatives not later than
9 fourteen days after the date of the Governor's declaration."
