"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF PERFLUOROALKYL OR POLYFLUOROALKYL SUBSTANCES IN CLASS B FIREFIGHTING FOAM."

1 Change the effective dates of sections 2 to 4, inclusive to "Effective
2 October 1, 2021"

3 Strike subdivision (10) of section 2 and insert the following in lieu
4 thereof:

5 "(10) "Intentionally introduced" means deliberately utilized regulated
6 metal or PFAS in the formulation of a package or packaging component
7 where the continued presence of such metal or PFAS is desired in the
8 final package or packaging component to provide a specific
9 characteristic, appearance or quality. The use of a regulated metal as a
10 processing agent or intermediate to impart certain chemical or physical

11 changes during manufacturing where the incidental retention of a
12 residue of said metal in the final package or packaging component is
13 neither desired nor deliberate shall not be considered intentional
14 introduction for the purposes of this section where such package or
15 component is in compliance with subsection (c) of section 22a-255i, as
16 amended by this act. The use of post-consumer recycled materials as
17 feedstock for the manufacture of new packaging materials where some
18 portion of the recycled materials may contain amounts of the regulated
19 metals or PFAS shall not be considered intentional introduction for the
20 purposes of this section provided the new package or packaging
21 component is in compliance with subsection (c) or (e) of section 22a-255i,
22 as amended by this act, as applicable."
