Title: AN ACT CONCERNING SEXUAL MISCONDUCT ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) protect students who report being a victim or witness of sexual assault, stalking or violence from disciplinary action by an institution of higher education, and (2) establish a Council on Sexual Misconduct Climate Survey to approve sexual misconduct climate surveys for use by institutions of higher education in the state.
