OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Cost In Bill

The amendment specifies that the Department of Housing use existing rental assistance certificates upon turnover for the Open Choice Vouchers pilot program, rather than the twenty additional certificates required in the underlying bill. As this eliminates the anticipated increase in state-supported rental assistance certificates, the amendment eliminates the cost in the underlying bill.
