No Fiscal Impact

The amendment adds four members to the Commission for Educational Technology (CET) within the Department of Administrative Services. The responsibilities of the commission include designing and managing the State Educational Technology Goals and Plan. The CET is responsible for coordinating the integration of technology into Connecticut's schools, libraries, and higher education institutions.

Annually by January first, the CET shall report to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents for Higher Education on its activities and progress made in the attainment of the state-wide technology goals.
