OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment could result in a cost to the Department of Social Services (DSS) associated with providing temporary assistance to domestic violence victims. The number of individuals who would qualify for diversion assistance or state administered general assistance and the value of the benefit under the amendment is unknown. The maximum benefit cannot exceed the equivalent of three months of Temporary Family Assistance benefits, which is approximately \$1,420 per case.
