Potential Cost

Section 501 results in a potential cost to local and regional school districts, in FY 22, associated with administering mental health screenings. The cost to the district would vary by the district size and number of staff available to administer the screenings. These costs would continue into FY 23 if the district opts to conduct another year of screenings.

Additionally, local and regional school districts must notify parents, in writing of the mental health screenings. This will result in a cost in FY 22 associated with supplies for providing written notification to every student and could result in a cost in FY 23 if the district opts to administer another year of mental health screenings.
