Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact. This amendment reduces the fee for a café permit for previous holders of nonprofit club and club permits from \$2,000 to \$300 for a club permit and \$815 for a nonprofit club permit resulting in an annual revenue loss of approximately \$540,000 beginning in FY 21¹. In FY 20 there were 338 club and nonprofit club permits.
