No Fiscal Impact

The amendment makes the sections containing the club and non-profit club permit fee reductions effective from passage resulting in no fiscal impact because the bill specifies these permittees will receive a refund in FY 21¹.

The amendment also makes a technical change resulting in no fiscal impact to the state.
