Explanation

The amendment requires anyone who operates certain facilities using flammable liquids to apply to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) for an extension for their plan on preventing the release of class B firefighting foam that intentionally contains added perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). This has no fiscal impact as DEEP currently has staff with expertise for this purpose.
