### **OFA Fiscal Note**

#### ***Potential Revenue Gain***

As the amendment allows any municipality or the state to impose a civil liability of \$500 for the first violation, \$1,000 for a second violation and \$2,000 for a third and subsequent violation of its provisions, it may result in a revenue gain to municipalities and the state to the extent violations occur, based on whichever entity brought the action. Any costs incurred in enforcing these provisions are recoverable by the Attorney General from the liable party.
