The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment establishes an eight-member Connecticut Information Privacy Commission. The commission shall appoint an executive director. The executive director shall appoint and employ a chief financial officer and other employees, consultants, agents and advisors, including legal counsel. The staff for the commission could cost up to \$1 million, including fringe benefits.

There is established an account to be known as the "Connecticut Privacy Commission account" which shall be a separate, non-lapsing account within the General Fund. The account shall contain any moneys required by law to be deposited in the account.

All civil administrative penalties assessed by the commission shall be paid to the state, to the State Treasurer. Once the payment is received, the state shall deposit ten per cent of any such penalty in the Connecticut Privacy Commission account, which will mitigate the expenses of the commission.
