The Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) shall waive the fee for any applicant for an identity card who does not have the means to pay such fee, including any applicant who is a resident of a homeless shelter or other facility for homeless persons. This will result in a revenue loss to the DMV.

The amendment allows any preprinted form of identification which shows the individual's name, address and photograph to vote in an election.

The amendment disallows a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector as valid voter identification.
