OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment establishes a fourteen-member working group to review animal cruelty laws. The working group shall examine penalties for animal cruelty imposed by laws of this state and other states and whether there are national or regional trends concerning changes to such penalties.

Not later than January 1, 2023, the working group shall issue a report including recommendations for legislation to the judiciary committee and to the Governor. The working group shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 1, 2023, whichever is later.

This bill has no fiscal impact as PA 17-236 prohibits transportation allowances for working group members.
