Eliminates Cost In Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment allows computer science to count toward the science, technology, engineering and mathematics credits. This does not result in a fiscal impact as it does not require a computer science course to be taken in order to graduate.
