### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment requires each beverage container sold in the state that has a refund value to have a Universal Product Code (UPC) and barcode and requires every deposit initiator to provide the UPC and barcode to the reverse vending machine administrators within a certain timeframe, effective in FY 24. This has no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities as it applies to private, third-parties.
