The amendment changes the effective dates of section 2 and 3 to sixty days after the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) determines there is an accurate test for acute cannabis intoxication. This delays the fiscal impact of the underlying bill until 60 days past certification of an accurate test.

The amendment also requires the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to conduct a monthly survey resulting in no fiscal impact to the state.
