"AN ACT REQUIRING THE REPORTING OF INCIDENTS THAT RESULTED IN SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURIES OR DEATH AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsections (a) and (b) of section 10a-55a of the general
4 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
5 (*Effective July 1, 2021*):

6 (a) [On or before October 1, 1991, and annually thereafter, each] Each
7 institution of higher education shall annually prepare [in such manner
8 as the president of the Connecticut State Colleges and Universities shall
9 prescribe] a uniform campus crime and safety incident report
10 concerning crimes committed and accidents occurring in the
11 immediately preceding calendar year within the geographical limits of
12 the property owned or under the control of such institution. [Such] The

13 portions of such report concerning criminal offenses shall be in
14 accordance with the uniform crime reporting system pursuant to section
15 29-1c, provided such report is limited to those offenses included in part
16 I of the most recently published edition of the Uniform Crime Reports
17 for the United States as authorized by the Federal Bureau of
18 Investigation and the United States Department of Justice, sexual assault
19 under section 53a-70b of the general statutes, revision of 1958, revised
20 to January 1, 2019, or sections 53a-70, 53a-70a, 53a-71, 53a-72a, 53a-72b
21 and 53a-73a, stalking under sections 53a-181c, 53a-181d and 53a-181e
22 and family violence as designated under section 46b-38h. The state
23 police, local police departments and special police forces established
24 pursuant to section 10a-156b shall cooperate with institutions of higher
25 education in preparing such reports. Institutions with more than one
26 campus shall prepare such reports for each campus.

27 (b) Each annual report prepared pursuant to subsection (a) of this
28 section shall include (1) the number of full-time equivalent students, (2)
29 the number of full-time equivalent employees, (3) the number of
30 students and employees residing in campus housing, [and] (4) for any
31 accident that occurred during the immediately preceding calendar year
32 within the geographical limits of the property owned or under the
33 control of an institution of higher education, (A) the number of such
34 accidents that resulted in serious physical injury, as defined in section
35 53a-3, and (B) the number of such accidents that resulted in death, and
36 (5) for each category of criminal offense, the number of incidents
37 reported and the crime rate. The crime rate shall be equal to the number
38 of incidents reported divided by the total number of full-time equivalent
39 students and employees."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2021</i>	10a-55a(a) and (b)
