1 Change the effective date of sections 15 and 50 to "Effective from
2 passage"

3 Strike lines 691 to 707, inclusive, in their entirety, and substitute the
4 following in lieu thereof:

5 "(g) Notwithstanding any provision of subsection (a) of this section,
6 food or nonalcoholic beverages may be sold, dispensed or consumed in
7 places operating under [an airport restaurant permit, an airport bar
8 permit or an airport airline club] a cafe permit issued pursuant to
9 subsection (d) of section 30-22a, at any time, as allowed by agreement
10 between the Connecticut Airport Authority and its lessees or
11 concessionaires. In the case of premises operating at Bradley
12 International Airport under [an airport airline club] a cafe permit, the
13 sale, dispensing or consumption or the presence in glasses or other
14 receptacles suitable to permit the consumption of alcoholic liquor by an

15 individual shall be unlawful on: (1) Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday,
16 Thursday and Friday between the hours of one o'clock a.m. and six
17 o'clock a.m., (2) Saturday and Sunday between the hours of two o'clock
18 a.m. and six o'clock a.m., (3) Christmas, except for alcoholic liquor that
19 is served where food is also available during the hours otherwise
20 permitted by this section for the day on which Christmas falls, and (4)
21 January first between the hours of three o'clock a.m. and six o'clock a.m."
