"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 Strike subsection (d) of section 1 and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(d) If the parents or guardian of any child are unable to pay for any
4 immunization required by subsection (a) of this section, the expense of
5 such immunization shall, on the recommendation of such child's local
6 or regional board of education, or similar body governing a nonpublic
7 school or schools, be paid by the town. If any child who (1) was exempt
8 from the appropriate provisions of this section prior to the effective date
9 of this section because such child or the parents or guardian of such
10 child presented a statement that immunizations would be contrary to
11 the religious beliefs of such child or the parents or guardian of such
12 child, (2) cannot meet the immunization requirements set forth in
13 subsection (a) of this section on or after the effective date of this section,
14 and (3) is unable to remain enrolled in any program operated by a public
15 or nonpublic school on or after the effective date of this section, the

16 municipality in which the child lives shall pay the expense of educating
17 the child and the state shall reimburse the municipality for the payment
18 of such expense."
