**"AN ACT CONCERNING HUMAN TRAFFICKING."**

1 Strike lines 170 to 176, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) At any time after a court enters a judgment of conviction, [is  
4 entered pursuant to section 53a-82] for any misdemeanor offense or a  
5 class C, D or E felony or any unclassified felony offense carrying a term  
6 of imprisonment of not more than ten years, the defendant may apply  
7 to the Superior Court to vacate [any] such judgment of conviction on the  
8 basis that his or her participation in the offense was a result of having  
9 been a victim of conduct of another person that constitutes (1) trafficking  
10 in persons under section 53a-192a, as amended by this act, or (2) a  
11 criminal violation of 18 USC Chapter 77, as amended from time to time."
