"AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND ALTERNATIVE SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Commissioners of Energy 4 and Environmental Protection and Public Health shall jointly conduct a 5 study to examine (1) existing categories of discharge that constitute (A) alternative on-site sewage treatment systems, as described in section 6 7 19a-35a of the general statutes, and (B) subsurface community sewerage 8 systems, as described in section 22a-430 of the general statutes, (2) 9 current administrative jurisdiction to issue or deny permits and 10 approvals for such systems, with reference to daily capacities of such 11 systems, and (3) the potential impacts of increasing the daily capacities 12 of such systems, including changes in administrative jurisdiction over 13 such systems and the timeframe for adoption of regulations to

14 implement any such changes in administrative jurisdiction.

(b) Not later than January 1, 2022, said commissioners shall submit to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to planning and development, the environment and public health, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, (1) a report on the findings of such study, and (2) recommendations for legislation to address any concern identified in such study."
