"AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND FINANCIAL LITERACY AS PART OF THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 10-221a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
5 *2021*):

6 (c) Commencing with classes graduating in 2023, and for each
7 graduating class thereafter, no local or regional board of education shall
8 permit any student to graduate from high school or grant a diploma to
9 any student who has not satisfactorily completed a minimum of twenty-
10 five credits, including not fewer than: (1) Nine credits in the humanities,
11 including civics and the arts; (2) nine credits in science, technology,
12 engineering and mathematics, which may include computer science; (3)

13 one credit in physical education and wellness; (4) one credit in health
14 and safety education, as described in section 10-16b; (5) one credit in
15 world languages, subject to the provisions of subsection (g) of this
16 section; and (6) a one credit mastery-based diploma assessment."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
