**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRESENCE OF PFAS IN CERTAIN  
CONSUMER PACKAGING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Energy and  
4 Environmental Protection, in conjunction with the Department of  
5 Emergency Services and Public Protection, shall study how to  
6 effectively enforce state statutes and regulations on bodies of water and  
7 adjacent roadways that cover more than one jurisdiction, including  
8 Beach Pond in Voluntown and its surrounding roadways. Not later than  
9 February 1, 2022, said departments shall submit a report to the joint  
10 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
11 matters relating to the environment on recommendations regarding any  
12 necessary positions to be created, allocations of funding to be adjusted  
13 and changes to agency jurisdiction that are necessary to accomplish such  
14 effective enforcement."
