***"AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE  
BENEFIT REVIEW."***

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2022*) (a) For the purposes of  
4 this section:

5 (1) "Health carrier" has the same meaning as provided in section 38a-  
6 1080 of the general statutes; and

7 (2) "Third-party administrator" has the same meaning as provided in  
8 section 38a-720 of the general statutes.

9 (b) Each health carrier or third-party administrator that issues a card  
10 to an individual in this state for the purpose of enabling such individual  
11 to prove that such individual has health coverage shall include in such  
12 card a statement disclosing whether such coverage is fully-insured or

13 self-insured. Such statement shall be prominently displayed on such  
14 card in a readily understandable, standardized form prescribed by the  
15 commissioner.

16 (c) The commissioner may adopt regulations, in accordance with the  
17 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to implement the  
18 provisions of this section.

19 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2021*) The executive director of the  
20 Office of Health Strategy, Insurance Commissioner, Comptroller and  
21 chief executive officer of the Connecticut Health Insurance Exchange  
22 established pursuant to section 38a-1081 of the general statutes, or their  
23 respective designees, shall make a concerted effort to submit testimony  
24 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
25 cognizance of matters relating to insurance on any proposed legislation  
26 that would amend any provision of title 38a of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
