"AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITHOUT HEALTH CARE COVERAGE."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2021*) (a) The Commissioner of
4 Social Services shall allocate any funding appropriated for the purpose
5 of expanding medical assistance to persons without legal immigration
6 status to support organizations that support homeless veterans. The
7 commissioner shall allocate six million nine hundred twenty-five
8 thousand in each of the fiscal years ending on June 30, 2022, and June
9 30, 2023, to (1) Homes for the Brave and Female Soldiers: Forgotten
10 Heroes in Bridgeport, (2) South Park Inn, Veteran's Services in Hartford,
11 (3) Columbus House, Harkness House for Veterans in New Haven, (4)
12 Easterseals Homeless Veteran Reintegration Program in Norwich and
13 Rocky Hill, (5) the New London Homeless Hospitality Center,

14 Transitional Housing for Veterans in New London, and (6) Fish of
15 Northwestern Connecticut, Life for Vets Program in Torrington.

16 (b) The commissioner shall require the organizations receiving such
17 funding to annually report on expenditures and may limit the amount
18 organizations may spend on administrative costs. The commissioner
19 shall, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4 of the general
20 statutes, submit reports not later than July 1, 2022, and July 1, 2023, on
21 services provided with the funding to the joint standing committees of
22 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
23 veterans."
