**"AN ACT CONCERNING PROVISIONS RELATED TO REVENUE  
AND OTHER ITEMS TO IMPLEMENT THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE  
BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2023."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 601. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2021*) (a) The State Board of  
4 Education shall not promulgate or authorize, and no local or regional  
5 board of education shall require or include in any course or portion of a  
6 curriculum, the following:

7 (1) One race or sex is inherently superior to another race or sex;

8 (2) An individual, by virtue of his or her race or sex, is inherently  
9 racist, sexist or oppressive, whether consciously or unconsciously;

10 (3) An individual's character is necessarily determined by his or her  
11 race or sex; or

12 (4) An individual, by virtue of his or her race or sex, bears  
13 responsibility for actions committed in the past by other members of the  
14 same race or sex.

15 (b) The State Board of Education shall develop rules to implement the  
16 provisions of this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
