Resolved by this House:

- 2 William H. Shehadi, Jr., a conserved person, by and through the
- 3 conservator of his estate, Albert B. Shehadi, v. State of Connecticut, et al.
- 4 Superior Court, Judicial District of Waterbury, Docket No. X06-UWY-
- 5 CV-18-6047615-S, dated March 22, 2022, requiring expenditure from the
- 6 General Fund budget in excess of two million five hundred thousand
- 7 dollars and submitted by the Attorney General to this Assembly for
- 8 approval in accordance with section 3-125a of the general statutes, are
- 9 approved.
