Explanation

The bill allows pharmacists to administer the flu vaccine to minors 12 years or older with parental consent and makes revisions to public health statutes resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

House "A" allows pharmacists to administer the flu vaccine to minors 12 years or older with parental consent resulting in the fiscal impact described above.
