## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

## ***Explanation***

The bill, which creates a taskforce to study the provision of indemnity or general liability insurance to persons licensed to practice medicine and surgery, who voluntarily accompany a state, regional or municipal special weapons and tactics team in connection with their law enforcement duties in order to render emergency medical assistance, does not result in a fiscal impact.

Senate "A" struck the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact and replaced it with the fiscal impact described above.
