AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF BATTERY-POWERED SMOKE DETECTORS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) (a) (1) On and after October
- 2 1, 2022, no person shall distribute, sell or offer for sale any smoke
- detection and warning equipment that is powered solely by a battery
- 4 unless such battery is nonreplaceable, nonremovable and capable of
- 5 powering the equipment for not less than ten years.
- 6 (2) The provisions of subdivision (1) of this subsection shall not apply
- 7 to any smoke detection and warning equipment that is powered by the
- 8 electrical system of a building, fire alarm systems with smoke detection
- 9 and warning equipment, fire alarm devices that connect to a panel, or
- 10 devices that use a low-power radio frequency wireless communication
- 11 signal.
- 12 (b) A person may sell smoke detection and warning equipment that
- does not meet the requirements of subsection (a) of this section on or
- 14 after October 1, 2022, if such person (1) possesses such equipment on
- 15 October 1, 2022, or (2) has placed an order for such equipment prior to

- 16 October 1, 2022.
- 17 (c) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be
- 18 fined not more than one hundred dollars for a first violation and not
- 19 more than five hundred dollars for a subsequent violation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:		
Section 1	from passage	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the sale of smoke detection and warning equipment that is powered solely by a battery unless the equipment has a nonremovable, nonreplaceable battery capable of powering the equipment for a minimum of ten years.
