AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEES AND EQUITABLE HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Administrative
2 Services shall study the benefits, implications and feasibility of
3 establishing an equitable holiday policy whereby full-time state
4 employees are able to substitute at least two current state holidays for
5 religious observances of their choosing. Not later than January 1, 2023,
6 the department shall report the results, in accordance with the
7 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, of such study and any
8 recommended legislation to the joint standing committee of the General
9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
