AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF ITINERANT FOOD VENDING ESTABLISHMENT LICENSES TO ALLOW FOR RECIPROCAL LICENSING OF SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the assessment of a
- 2 fifty-cent fee for the issuance or renewal of a license for itinerant food
- 3 vending establishments, which fee shall be used by the Department of
- 4 Public Health to permit reciprocal licensing for itinerant food vending
- 5 establishments throughout the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To assess a fee on itinerant food vending establishment licensees to be used by the Department of Public Health to permit reciprocal licensing for itinerant food vending establishments throughout the state.
