**Substitute Bill No. 334**

**AN ACT MAKING THE COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE KNOWLEDGE TEST AVAILABLE TO CERTAIN INCARCERATED PERSONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) (a) As used in this section,  
2 "disqualification" has the same meaning as provided in section 14-1 of  
3 the general statutes.

4 (b) Not later than January 1, 2023, the Commissioner of Correction  
5 shall make suitable space and technology, as necessary, available for the  
6 administration of the commercial driver's license knowledge test to  
7 incarcerated persons who will be reentering the community in six  
8 months or less and who are not subject to disqualification from driving  
9 a commercial motor vehicle or subject to suspension, revocation or  
10 cancellation of operating privileges in any state.

11 (c) Not later than January 1, 2023, the Commissioner of Motor  
12 Vehicles shall assign personnel and provide other resources, as  
13 necessary, to administer the commercial driver's license knowledge test  
14 in a written or electronic manner in any institution or facility of the  
15 Department of Correction deemed appropriate by the Commissioners  
16 of Motor Vehicles and Correction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
