AN ACT EXEMPTING VETERANS FROM PAYMENT OF THE FARES FOR BUS PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2022*) Any person who is a veteran,
2 as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103 of the general statutes, shall
3 be exempt from payment of the lawful charge for state-owned or state-
4 controlled bus public transportation service, provided such person
5 presents to the fare inspector, as defined in section 13b-2 of the general
6 statutes, or the driver of such bus, as applicable, a motor vehicle
7 operator's license or identity card indicating such person's status as a
8 veteran, in accordance with subsection (e) of section 14-36h of the
9 general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
