**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN GAS TAXES, THE EXTENSION OF FREE BUS SERVICE, BOTTLE DEPOSIT LABELS AND FUNDING FOR THE CONNECTICUT PREMIUM PAY PROGRAM AND ENERGY ASSISTANCE."**

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 1 of special act 22-2, as amended  
3 by section 431 of public act 22-118, is amended to read as follows  
4 (*Effective from passage*):

5 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraphs (A) and (B) of  
6 subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 12-458 of the general statutes,  
7 from April 1, 2022, to [November 30, 2022] June 30, 2023, inclusive, the  
8 tax imposed under said subparagraphs shall not apply to fuels or  
9 gasohol sold or used by a distributor in this state. Nothing in this section  
10 shall be construed to affect the tax due pursuant to subparagraphs (C)  
11 to (E), inclusive, of subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 12-458 of

12 the general statutes on propane, natural gas or diesel sold or used by a  
13 distributor in this state. As used in this section, "distributor" and "fuels"  
14 have the same meanings as provided in section 12-455a of the general  
15 statutes and "gasohol" has the same meaning as provided in section 14-  
16 1 of the general statutes."
