Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS DEDUCTION FROM THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX AND THE QUALIFYING INCOME THRESHOLD FOR MARRIED INDIVIDUALS FILING JOINTLY.

Statement of Purpose: To increase the qualifying income threshold for the full Social Security benefits deduction from the personal income tax for married individuals filing jointly, to twice the amount of the qualifying income threshold for an unmarried individual.
