**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY NURSING SERVICES AGENCIES, REPORTING OF INVOLUNTARY TRANSFERS AND DISCHARGES FROM NURSING HOMES AND RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES, ELDER ABUSE TRAINING, LEGAL RIGHTS OF LONG-TERM CARE APPLICANTS AND A STUDY OF MANAGED RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY ISSUES.

**Statement of Purpose:** To require that temporary nursing services agencies register with the Department of Public Health and that the Department of Social Services set maximum rates for such services provided to nursing homes.
