Title: AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE-WIDE PROPERTY TAX ON CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY.

Statement of Purpose: To establish a state-wide property tax at the rate of 2 mills on residential real property with an assessed value of greater than one million two hundred thousand dollars and to dedicate such revenue to fund excess cost grants under subsection (b) of section 10-76g of the general statutes and settlement costs of the Sheff v. O'Neill lawsuit.
