Title: AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN ENERGY-EFFICIENT HOMES.

Statement of Purpose: To establish, for the taxable years commencing January 1, 2022, through January 1, 2025, inclusive, a one-time credit against the personal income tax, in the amount of two thousand five hundred dollars for a person filing as an unmarried individual and five thousand dollars for married individuals filing jointly, for taxpayers that purchase a newly constructed home in the state with a score of sixty or higher on the Home Energy Rating System Index.
