Title: AN ACT CONCERNING RECORD-KEEPING AND PARENTAL NOTIFICATION OF CERTAIN INCIDENTS INVOLVING CHILDREN BY CHILD CARE CENTERS AND GROUP CHILD CARE HOMES.

Statement of Purpose: To require the Commissioner of Early Childhood to adopt regulations to require child care centers, group child care homes and family child care homes to (1) immediately notify a parent or guardian upon the transport of a child to a hospital emergency room, doctor's office or other medical facility, (2) create and maintain records concerning incidents resulting in injury or illness to children enrolled in such centers or homes, and (3) provide copies of such records to such children's parents or guardians and the Office of Early Childhood.
