Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES' RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING VARIOUS REVISIONS TO DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES STATUTES.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) allow the Commissioner of Developmental Services to require applicants seeking employment with an individual funded by the department for self-directed services to submit to a check for substantiated complaints in the Department of Children and Families child abuse and neglect registry, (2) require the appointment of a licensed medical professional in lieu of a doctor of medicine to the Council on Developmental Services, (3) require the Department of Developmental Services to find that a person has intellectual disability before a Probate Court may place such person with the department for services, and (4) allow the Commissioner of Developmental Services' designee to perform certain functions in Probate Court proceedings.
