OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact, and results in the fiscal impact below.

The amendment requires the Insurance Commissioner to conduct a study of short-term health insurance policies, including an examination of their viability in Connecticut and to report the results of the study to the Insurance and Real Estate Committee by January 1, 2023. The amendment has no fiscal impact as the Insurance Department has the necessary expertise to complete the study required by the amendment.
