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## **OFA Fiscal Note**

### **No Fiscal Impact**

The amendment strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment specifies that Probate Court orders are only applied to the extent permitted by federal law, provided the Probate Court has statutory jurisdiction to issue such order, and any aggrieved party (including state agencies) may appeal. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state.

The amendment also requires the Department of Social Services to annually report, beginning 1/1/24, on data related to instances where a Probate Court issues an order or decree concerning assets or income of an individual, which impacts such individual's Medicaid eligibility. This has no fiscal impact.
